

Facility and Stalling Information

1. Vet and color check from 12:00 noon to 8:00pm on Friday, September 30, 2011. All alpacas must be in place by 8:00pm Friday evening. No unloading prior to 12:00 noon. All alpacas must vacate facility by 8:00pm Sunday, October 2, 2011.
2. All alpacas must be stalled for the duration of the show, but may be released once they have completed their registered classes. Companion animals (alpacas not entered in the show) are not permitted.
3. Exhibitors must be entered in the show to rent a stall or display stall.
4. Stall space is limited and assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis, by postmark. Grand, Gold and Silver sponsors will receive preferred stalling based on receipt of their sponsorship payment.
5. Grand and Gold Sponsors will be located at the main aisle ways and will have display areas extending into the aisle ways. No other tack or display will be permitted in the main and stalling aisle ways.
6. All stalls are 10' x 10' horse stalls on asphalt flooring. Stall price includes straw bedding. Exhibitors are welcome to bring stall mats to augment the bedding provided. No other bedding may be used. Hay and feed must be provided by the exhibitor.
7. Electricity and water (including hot and cold water in wash bays) are available at strategic points throughout the stall area. Please bring your own electric cords for fans. Fans are permitted in the stalls but not in the aisle way.
8. No more than 4 (four) yearling and older or 5 (five) juvenile alpaca per stall. Stalls cannot be divided.
9. Display spaces 10' x 10', priced at \$65.00, are available ringside the main Huacaya halter ring. **These spaces are for farm displays only, may not stall alpacas and may not display commercial products for sale.** Vendor booths, priced at \$125.00, are available for retail sales.
10. Tack stalls (without bedding) adjacent to the horse stalls are available at \$45.00. All tack must be stored out of the aisle ways.
11. Farm displays are encouraged, but they may not extend into the aisle way – with the exception of the sponsor farm displays.
12. Exhibitors may bring panels 48" wide to fit in stall doorways for daytime use.
13. Dogs will not be permitted in the show facility and must be kept on leash on the show grounds.
14. Camping is \$20.00 per night, paid to the National Champions' Alpaca Show. All sites have electric hookups. There is a dump station on the premises. The show facility has a full service restaurant, rest rooms and showers. Spaces are first-come, first-served.
15. Each registration packet will contain a card for emergency contact information. Please be sure to complete the card in full and to affix it to the front of your stall.
16. Parents are responsible for their children. Children are to be kept under supervision at all times.
